We provide airfield and airport operations management, flight crew training and instructor services for both UAS and manned aircraft, current operations and crew scheduling support, health and emergency services support, temporary staffing and personnel augmentation, and management consulting and program support grounded in Lean Six Sigma principles. Our principal's credentials include MQ-9 UAS and C-17 pilot and instructor experience, current operations leadership for a C-17 airlift squadron, Flight Training Unit instructor roles, Air Force Flight Safety Program management, alert facility management, and a medic/EMT background, along with GOCO and contractor instructor roles. Although newly formed, Talon ADI leverages extensive military and contractor experience to support government and commercial clients as a prime or subcontractor.
